## **PRESS RELEASE**

Karachi - The ever increasing inflation in Pakistan has made the life unbearable for blue Collar Community of the society. Despite back breaking labour & hours of rigorous working they are not able to meet their ends. Alamgir Welfare Trust Int'l provides relief packages to those underprivileged people periodically.

Such is the situation for the poor working class which made their life an agony. They simply can not afford even two square meals for their kids. Malnutrition is creating severe health issues in women & children. To curb this serious problem, Alamgir Welfare Trust Int'l has initiated a well organized Token system programme through which thousands of Kilogram of Sadqa meat would be distributed to 1500 families living in slums and suburbs of Karachi, said Mr. Shakeel Dehelvi, Spokesman, Alamgir Trust.

These special cards have been distributed at the door steps of needy people to receive 5 kg of mutton monthly on each card. Each card is valid for six months.

Apart from that, Nearly 12,500 Kg meat is distributed to two hundred educational institutions, 4500 Kg to patients at various hospitals of the city and 1000 Kg to eradicate Malnutrition in TB & Gyne patients at Alamgir Health Care hospital. Not only this, but women and children, seeking treatment at Alamgir Health Care Hospital are fed between 12pm to 2pm daily at Alamgir Welfare Trust. Mr. Dehelvi also stated that over 750 patients are cured daily at the General OPD of Hospitals run by Alamgir Welfare Trust Int'l at Hubriver Road, Taiser Town and Aalmgir Masjid Bahadurabad spending around ten millions monthly.
